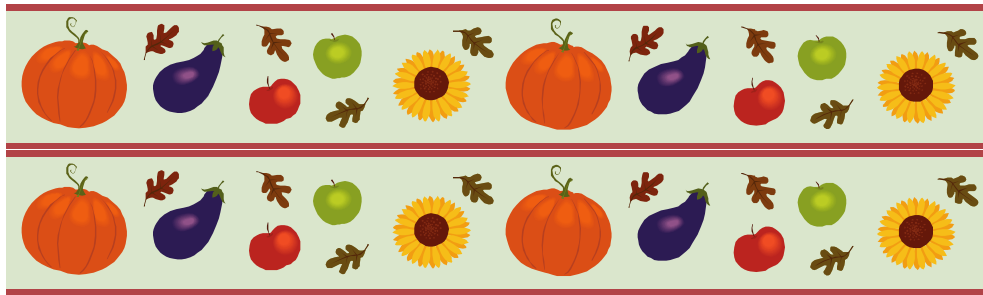
There is a new show being produced at Wareham Access Television called "Talk & Roll". The program features interviews with Rock & Roll Bands from the 50's 60's & 70's and the music that made them great. It's an orphan right now and it's looking for a sponsor. It's a monthly show and comes highly recommended from the WATV's Executive Director. Russ has a DVD of the program if you'd like to borrow it and review it in case you're interested in reviewing it.

No MONEY is involved in sponsoring a show. IT'S FREE! Sponsorship simply means that the resident is willing to become the local contact for THAT program and, if necessary, arrange for pick up or delivery of disc's to EBCTV. One caveat, sponsors are legally responsible for the content of the show they are sponsoring but don't let this scare you. There are already tons of shows being sponsored on EBCTV such as: Physician Focus, Pet Zone, Army Newswatch, Pure Heart Clear Mind and so on...

So don't let that part scare you. If you're not sure whether you want to sponsor a show then simply ask the producer to give you/mail you a copy of the show so that you can preview it before you decide. It's a fun way of being active at EBCTV and getting the types of shows you want to see on YOUR Community Access Station.

Learn about sound equipment and how to use special microphones.

Basic Studio Production: This 4 session, two hour per session workshop teaches the fundamentals of Basic Television Studio Production. Learn how to operate a studio camera. Students will work outside and do hands on activities in and with the Van when weather is permitting.

East Bridgewater Cable Advisory Board Holds Ascertainment Hearing in Packed Room

This past Tuesday, October 28th the East Bridgewater Cable Advisory Board held their Ascertainment Hearing at the Main Conference Room (Selectmen Chamber) at Town Hall. The purpose of the Hearing was to get input from resident/subscribers regarding what they like and don't like about their Comcast Service.

The room was packed beyond capacity with PRO-P.E.G. Access People. They were there to convince Comcast that the community meant business when they said they wanted P.E.G. Access to remain in East Bridgewater and flourish (Public Educational Government Access Television). Residents, Producers, and Cable Subscribers all had the opportunity to speak on the issue. A variety of topics were covered including equipment improvements, facility improvements and enhancements and staff augmentations. Members and residents also spoke about how important P.E.G. Access was to them and the community.

Comcast Representative Cathy Maloney was there to listen to the Town's Residents and make note of what they wanted. She spoke briefly at the end of the hearing. According to Ms Maloney and the EB Cable Advisory Board, the process will now continue as both Comcast & the C-A-B continue to ascertain the needs of the community. The current cable contract ends in December of 2009. The East Bridgewater Cable Advisory Board is optimistic that the contract can be renewed prior to the end of the current contract.
