EBHS-EBCTV Club Activities...



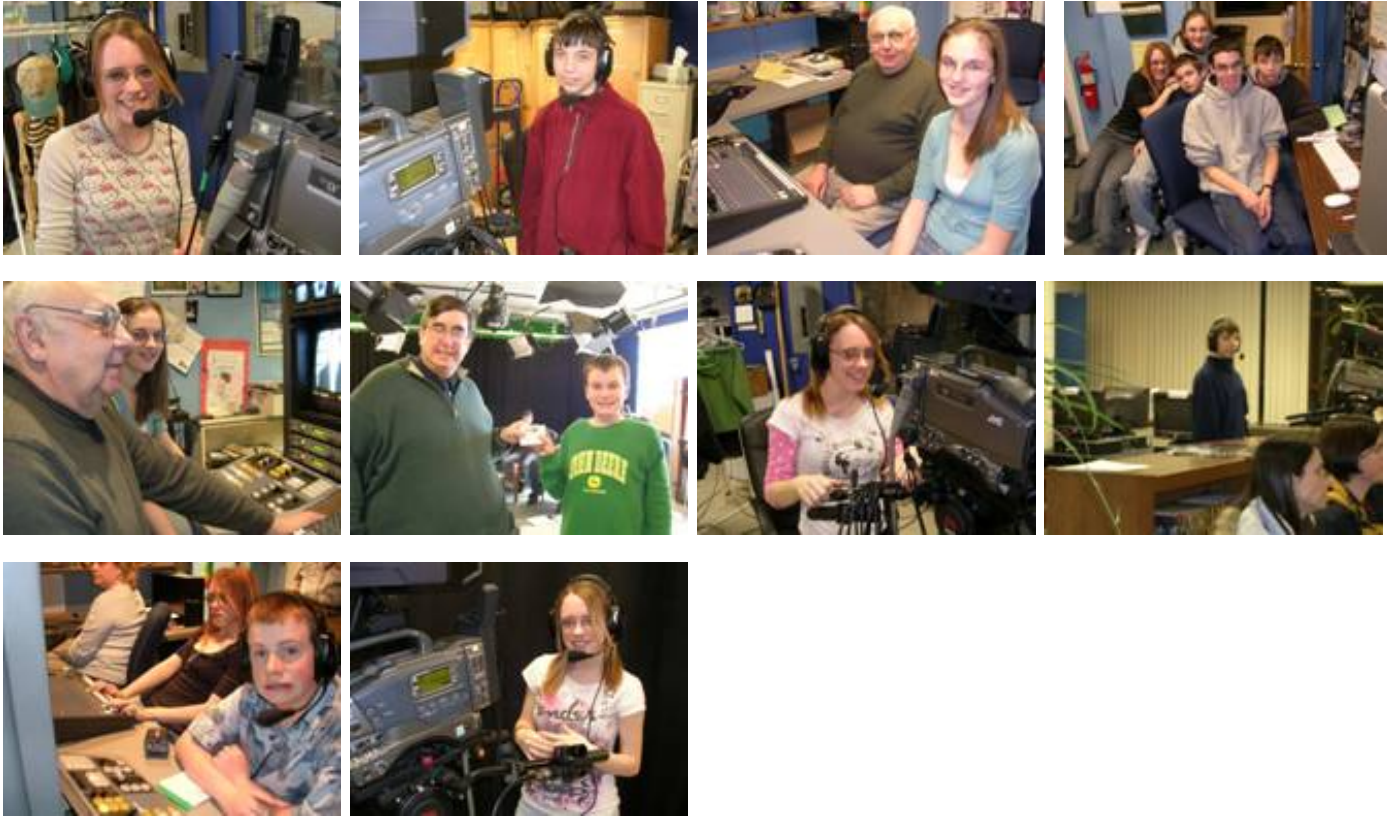

Cable Studio's rebirth Celebrated at Open House

Gloucester - When Cape Ann TV took over operations of channels 12 and 67 last July it was a big step forward for the creative community on Cape Ann. Cape Ann TV is a non-profit, tax-exempt corporation that provides public access television programming to Gloucester, Essex, Manchester and Rockport. Before Comcast stepped back Cape Ann TV took over, Comcast directed public access channels 12 and 67. Though Comcast remains as Cape Ann's cable provider, the control of the public access channels has completely switched hands. Comcast does however still provide Cape Ann TV with basic funding, something Cape Ann TV director Sinikka Nogelo says is quite important.

"It's a very good position for a non-profit to be in, to know that our basic costs and business expenses are covered," she said. Cape Ann TV's facility at 38 Blackburn Center recently underwent a series of renovations, which were unveiled last Thursday night, March 6, at an open house. Nogelo, who got involved with the station in 1984, said the event was intended to showcase the studio and the opportunities it provides to Cape Ann residents.

"Tonight we want to hear from the community," she said. "We're here to serve them. Our basic mission is to provide the public with access to the TV medium. It is our job to help the people make the television." Nogelo also noted the importance of free speech as a core to any functional society and stressed the importance that that programming is "bottom up," meaning created and defined by the viewers. And with the relatively low cost of membership fees (\$20 per year for individual, \$100 per year for tax exempt non-profits, \$150 per year for businesses), such is possible.

Members of Cape Ann TV get full access to the studio and all its trappings: cameras, tapes and editing suites (Cape Ann TV uses Final Cut Express, iMovie, Casablanca and Avid). Members can attend classes and learn how to use the equipment, and can even make their own shows to air on Cape Ann TV.

"It's such a good deal, and you get to learn and be creative at the same time," said Nogelo. She lauded the Cape for its creative community and said it has been a pleasure working at Cape Ann TV for as long as she has. "I really found something worth working for. I enjoyed the communities, the people. They're so creative. Working with the people of Cape Ann has been such a pleasure."

Jason Whitett, the manager of government and community relations at Comcast in Beverly, explained Comcast's financial contribution to Cape Ann TV. Comcast provides a percentage of the revenues from each of the four Cape Ann communities," he said. "Those percentages go to the studio, which uses them as its operating budget." Whitett said the model put forth by a public access corporation truly brings the community into the process, especially today.

"(Access corporations) are able to cultivate the Youtube culture," said Whitett. "It's now cool, hip, to be involved with video. ... You can come here and get access to all of the studio's equipment, to all the tools you want. You can get skills here that you couldn't get at a college. This is a tremendous resource for Cape Ann."

The open house also marked the beginning of a partnership between Cape Ann TV and seARTS, a non-profit arts service organization made up of a coalition of Cape Ann artists, cultural institutions, businesses and municipal partners whose mission is to stimulate the economy through art. Thirty-seven

works from 20 seARTS artists were on display at the open house and will continue to be through the end of the month.

Sara Young, seARTS executive director, said, "We're really looking forward to this. We think it will be an ongoing partnership." Nogelo was enthused by the idea of future partnerships. "As we grow we'd like to band together with some groups and work with them and their mission by using TV," she said, citing non-profits and schools specifically.

Stacey Randall, a member of the Cape Ann TV Board of Directors, urged Cape Ann's youth to get involved. "We've got to get the youth voice of Cape Ann out there," she said. "There are so many positive things going on — it's the video generation. It would be an amazing development." Randall also said one of Cape Ann TV's long term goals is to establish satellite stations in each of the Cape's high schools. "That's down the road a ways, but it would be amazing," she said.

Rebecca Baylies of Cape Ann Animal Aid said using Cape Ann TV has increased interest in their animals. "It's great because people who cannot get down to the shelter and actually see the animals in person can see them on TV. This is a great way to reach people," said Baylies.

Jazz singer Henri Smith, who performed a set at the open house, hosts a show dedicated to jazz called "N'Awlins East." Smith, a native of New Orleans, was uprooted when Hurricane Katrina ravaged the city in 2005. After Katrina hit Smith found himself in Houston. Then Hurricane Rita struck and uprooted the vocalist again. He said he had a friend in Nat Simpkins on the Cape.

"Nat called and asked if I wanted to come to Cape Ann." So he did. "I started getting gigs and I've been up here ever since." Smith hosted a program similar to "N'Awlins East" before Katrina hit called "New Orleans Live," along with a couple of radio shows. For Smith, Cape Ann TV has provided an opportunity to reclaim a part of what he loves so dearly, his city.

Another jazzman, Ed Carfano, was on hand at the open house. Carfano hosts "Stardust," a program also dedicated to playing jazz music, and featuring a band of the same name. Carfano, who won an Oscar in 1960 for the short film "Day of the Painter," which he helped produce, and whose film production company Ed Carr Production Ltd. made the famed "Like Father, Like Son" anti-smoking commercial, knows a thing or two about film. "Stardust" has been airing on channel 12 for the past 13 months. Carfano said he rediscovered just a few years ago his passion for singing.

"I was doing a lot of saloon work," Carfano explains. "But things got so busy [with his production company] that I had to give up entertaining. But then a few years ago I decided that if I could get a band together that I could sing again."

The beauty of Cape Ann TV is that anyone can become a member and get access to the studio's myriad resources.
