The Producers of these shows (historically known as "Bicycled Tapes") are looking for local residents of East Bridgewater, who are members of EBCTV, to sponsor their shows.

Local TV wants space at new Norwood High

Since its inception five years ago, Norwood Public Access Television has made its home at the high school - an arrangement the corporation hopes the state will allow to continue in the proposed new facility. Norwood Public Access hopes the state's building authority will approve a request to include roughly 500 square feet for offices and storage in the design of a new high school.

The corporation uses about 100 square feet for office and storage. Its studio, which it shares with students in the television production program, is also at the high school, and the state has agreed to include space for that at the new Norwood High. Public Access President Scott Murphy said yesterday the corporation will pay the cost of the additional space, but said it's unclear whether the authority will give the OK.

"We think we've had a good partnership with the high school and we'd like to stay there if we can," said Murphy.

The Massachusetts School Building Authority has authorized the town to begin designing a new school that meets its education guidelines. Cost estimates on the school are expected to be completed by fall and a debt exclusion override question to fund construction will likely be put on the annual town election ballot for April 2009. Murphy said project managers and architects have met with the Norwood Public Access board of directors about the request and indicated they don't know whether the authority will look favorably upon it or not.

"It's up in the air right now," said Murphy. "If they say no, then we'll have to go to Plan B and find a space to rent somewhere."

But Murphy believes moving out of the high school would be a blow to the school's Television Production program, which now has access to Norwood Public Access resources.

"We've probably purchased more than \$100,000 worth of new equipment over the past four years - the 20 IMac (computer) editing stations in the television production class, we paid for those," said Murphy. "So, we feel being there is a benefit for us and a benefit for the school."

"The equipment is used by both NPA and the School Department, and I think it's an integral part of the educational program," said School Committee member and Public Access board member Dick Kief.

Town officials and project managers are continuing to meet with the authority to discuss additional space requests, including the television offices and more space in the gym auditorium, cafeteria and music and drama rooms. The authority has not yet decided what it will do about requests for additional space, even if cities and towns offer to pay for it in entirety.

"Whether these things are paid for by the town or not, MSBA has not taken a position on whether they will allow any additional square footage to the project," said Phil Poinelli of Symmes, Maini & McKee Associates, which will be designing the school.

Norwood is hoping the state authority reimburses it for roughly half the cost of the school, which the building authority has stated it does not expect to exceed \$100 million. Kief hopes fellow School Committee members will consider the Norwood Public Access request seriously when members meet later this month to prioritize the list of requests.

"It's an ideal partnership in my mind and I hope we do everything in our power to support that," said Kief.
