Besides attending workshops on Copyright Law and Building new Facilities, participants "Stormed the Hill". "Storm the Hill" is a regular event when ever the ACM holds its Annual Conference in DC. Volunteers, Producers and staff from access centers across the United States visit their respective Senators and Congressmen to remind them of how important "Local Franchising" of Cable Licenses is to P.E.G. PUBLIC, EDUCATIONAL & GOVERNMENT ACCESS TELEVISION:

**PLYMOUTH –PACTV Moves!
July 18, 2008**

The packing has been going on for some time now, but Plymouth Area Community Access Television will officially move out of its 130 Court St. home next Wednesday (July 23) after 10 years there.

PACTV has a new 6,200-square-foot home at 4 Collins Ave. in the Plymouth Industrial Park featuring two studios, offices for administration and outreach, training, technical support and storage. The new facility was designed by architect Jeffrey Metcalfe.

PACTV Executive Director Nancy Richard said the PACTV offices will be closed to the public for a few weeks but are expected to open on Collins Avenue by Friday, Aug. 15. During that time, the playback system will be set up at the old office so PACTV can continue to offer programming. While there may be some lag time before government meetings are rebroadcast, she said meetings will be covered live as usual. PACTV provides public and government access programming on

Channels 13 and 15 in Plymouth and Channel 14 in Kingston. Richard said shows produced elsewhere will be on hiatus.

“Channels won’t be black,” Richard said. “We’ll still be showing all our in-house produced programming.” Telephone service may also be interrupted, but Richard said PACTV will be able to accept e-mails at pactv@pactv.org. Plans are in the works for a grand opening at the beginning of October, according to Richards. A capital campaign is under way to raise \$184,000 to cover building costs. Donations are being accepted online at www.pactv.org.
