Orientation: This monthly Two-hour workshop is offered the first Wednesday night of each month and is Free and with no obligation to all new members. The Orientation covers all the rules & procedures for the facility, a question and answer period and tour of the facility.

PUBLIC, EDUCATIONAL & GOVERNMENT ACCESS TELEVISION:

City of Reno to sue Charter over Public Access Channels

The Reno City Council has asked the city attorney to file a lawsuit against Charter Communications in an effort to block the cable company from moving local community access channels to "cyberspace," forcing up to 9,000 customers to rent special equipment to watch these channels. The cable company intends to relocate the four channels to the 200 level on Tuesday.

Councilman Dave Aiuzzi made the motion for a temporary restraining order, "so we can get more time to come to an agreement. We owe it to our citizens to try."

Councilman Dan Gustin abstained from voting because of business interests with Charter.

Another lawsuit or a motion to tag onto the city's lawsuit will be filed by Resurge.tv, a group representing viewers and public access show producers, said Andrew Barbano, its leader.

Cable customers who don't have digital TV sets will have to pay \$5 a month for converter boxes to watch the access channels, which includes live broadcasts of local government boards.

Reno, Sparks, public access, and Washoe County channels are now seen on channels 13, 15, 16 and 17. After several days of negotiations with city officials, Charter submitted a letter offering several changes to make the move easier on customers, including free installation of the converter boxes.

Charter is offering a 20 percent discount, offsetting the \$5 increase for basic service customers, to low-income people who get similar discounts in city services if they can prove an economic hardship. Similar discounts are offered to Sparks and Washoe County customers. And to ensure viewers still can find the community access channels by "surfing," Charter can electronically map the community access stations back to their old locations as well as keep them on the 200 level.

The move still clears analog space that Charter can use to offer more than a dozen new digital channels. Hardship consideration Councilwoman Sharon Zadra grilled Charter spokesman George Jostlin on whether all 9,000 customers could be considered hardship cases because they will have to pay extra for something they now are getting for free.

Jostlin repeatedly responded that the discount would apply only to those who qualify for a reduction for city services, such as a sewer bill. Councilman Dave Aiuzzi asked Jostlin whether the cable company would offer a \$50 gift certificate to people who would rather buy a new digital TV rather than rent a box. "That's something the city and the big-box stores need to look at," Jostlin said.
