## Sponsors Wanted...

Welcome to a new section of the EBCTV E-News. In this section we will post information about Public, Educational, and Government Access Shows Produced at other Access Facilities. The Producers of these shows (historically known as "Bicycled Tapes") are looking for local residents of East Bridgewater, who are members of EBCTV, to sponsor their shows.

There is a new show being produced at Wareham Access Television called "Talk & Roll". The program features interviews with Rock & Roll Bands from the 50's 60's & 70's and the music that made them great. It's an orphan right now and it's looking for a sponsor. It's a monthly show and comes highly recommended from the WATV's Executive Director. Russ has a DVD of the program if you'd like to borrow it and review it in case you're interested in reviewing it.

No MONEY is involved in sponsoring a show. IT'S FREE! Sponsorship simply means that the resident is willing to become the local contact for THAT program and, if necessary, arrange for pick up or delivery of disc's to EBCTV. One caveat, sponsors are legally responsible for the content of the show they are sponsoring but don't let this scare you. There are already tons of shows being sponsored on EBCTV such as: Physician Focus, Pet Zone, Army Newswatch, Pure Heart Clear Mind and so on...

So don't let that part scare you. If you're not sure whether you want to sponsor a show then simply ask the producer to give you/mail you a copy of the show so that you can preview it before you decide. It's a fun way of being active at EBCTV and getting the types of shows you want to see on YOUR Community Access Station.

The Following are courses & workshops currently being offered by East Bridgewater Community Television to our Members:

**Orientation:** This monthly Two-hour workshop is offered the first Wednesday night of each month and is Free and with no obligation to all new members. The Orientation covers all the rules & procedures for the facility, a question and answer period and tour of the facility.

Learn how to use a camcorder to shoot great video. Learn how a portable lighting kit will make your show look just like the network shows. Learn about sound equipment and how to use special microphones.

**Basic Studio Production:** This 4 session, two hour per session workshop teaches the fundamentals of Basic Television Studio Production. Learn how to operate a studio camera. Learn how to direct a TV show just like the network shows. Learn about studio sound equipment and how to choose the right microphone. Learn about television graphics.

**"Remote Mobile Production Van":** Learn all the tricks to creating a three camera video production using EBCTV's State of the Art Mobile Production Van! Students will work outside and do hands on activities in and with the Van when weather is permitting.

### *Hopkinton cable chairman inspired by Disney World visit*

Following a tour of the Walt Disney World television studios, town cable access manager Jim Cozzens returned home hoping to revise his studio's Web site before the fall season to convey the inspiration he felt. "I wanted the Web site to reflect the fun and cool aspects of television production," he said, referring to [www.hcam.tv](http://www.hcam.tv), the homepage for Hopkinton's HCAM station. The redesigned site features a new navigation bar with stylish icons and staff blogs, as well as a section for online video clips. For now, the station is only offering short announcements and promotional segments via the Internet, but thanks to newly discovered software it will soon offer full-length shows.

"I wanted to make sure it was going to be high quality," Cozzens said. "That's why we're rolling it out now."

Also making their debut this season are three new shows. In "Friends Forever," resident Cheryl Melody will use puppets to produce the station's first program for children. In "Vets Remember," Dick Gooding speaks with veterans about the atmosphere in the country when they served. And in "Attitude," Mary Arnault and guests will discuss current events from a female perspective.

"I don't know if I'd say 'Hopkinton's Oprah,' but it's that type of show," Cozzens said, noting that the station had purchased a leather couch and love seat for the new set.

Those interested in volunteering for the station or creating their own shows can sign up for a series of five sessions starting in October, focusing on film production, camera work, control board operation, directing and editing.

"It's a \$200,000 studio," Cozzens said. "We need to give you some experience on the equipment first." Once trained, residents can sign-up for e-mails from shows looking for help or seek out a crew for their own program idea. "We have a wide variety of things going on and there are plenty of opportunities," Cozzens said.
